Chesnay-Rocquencourt opens its doors to the MOBOTIX door station

Residents' security is at the heart of the device

Located close to the Palace of Versailles gardens in Yvelines, the town of Chesnay-Rocquencourt has close to 34,000 inhabitants. Over several years, it has defined a security policy that responds to a certain type of crime generated by the quality of life in the town. That is why Chesnay-Rocquencourt decided to install an effective surveillance system. Since 2007, it has continuously been improving the security of its inhabitants, initially installing a video surveillance system of 14 cameras, followed by a second wave of 33 additional cameras. The equipment is monitored 24 hours a day from the newly established town surveillance center and supported by a nearby quick-response municipal police force.

Located in the town hall, the town surveillance center comprises a dozen supervisors led by Arnaud Rogiez, appointed by the mayor to oversee video surveillance. Outside of the hours of municipal police presence, the town surveillance center takes over, allowing continuous surveillance thanks to the 18 monitors.

The municipality's aims are numerous: to ensure the security of residents, to be able to respond

quickly in the event of an incident, and to offer a constant listening service for residents through a switchboard.

Multi-functional MOBOTIX door stations

It is in this spirit that 22 MOBOTIX video door stations have recently been installed. This enables numerous access points to be managed remotely. Squares, car parks, schools, crèches, retirement homes, etc. are just some of the many public places where it was necessary to secure access in these times of widespread insecurity. "For example, in the event of a fire in the secure waiting area of a car park, the installation of a door station allows constant contact between the security station and the individuals, who are therefore reassured due to being better informed of how the incident is being handled," explains Arnaud Rogiez.

There are approximately 20 municipal police interventions each month. The use of the video surveillance system far exceeds the mere issue of crime. "With the town surveillance center, we also manage alarms and crisis situations such as road accidents.

We provide a service to the population. It is also a means of gathering information,” explains Philippe Brillault, the mayor of the town.

The different functions of the MOBOTIX door stations are therefore all used:

- Remote surveillance, thanks to a high-quality video sensor.
- The intercom, which complements the existing telephone answering device.
- Managing access from the town surveillance center, with quick and secure entry using a badge or code.

This equipment was discovered at a trade show. Among the many competing models, it was the MOBOTIX access control device that was ultimately selected as the best product on the market.

The installation and configuration of the most recent MOBOTIX door stations have been carried out by ADS2, which has specialized in MOBOTIX

products for over ten years. For its director, Denis Follain: *“These door stations not only provide new functions to manage access security to public buildings equipped with them, but also integrate and complement the town’s video surveillance system, through their centralization at the town surveillance center.”*

In fact, with the activation of the SIPELIA module, MOBOTIX video door stations have been integrated into the Genetec Security Center, enabling town surveillance center operators to manage them with the same interface (HMI) as the other video surveillance cameras.
