Access management and GDPR compliance: the MOBOTIX CLOUD as a solution

The continuous growth of DFNBG Gastro GmbH & Co. KG reflects the success of the Nuremberg-based company. At the same time, it also presents the company with challenges, which became apparent in the security system, for example, when it became increasingly complex to manage the access rights of the growing number of employees. In addition, the requirements with regard to data protection regulations for the VMS on site grew, requiring, among other things, a separate room and constantly additional security standards. The requirements were difficult to meet, especially for branch locations in shopping arcades.

Once again, VALEO IT Neteye had the right solution with the MOBOTIX CLOUD. For the past four years, Dunkin's branches have been gradually migrating from local NAS (network-attached storage) to the cloud-based, data protection-compliant video management system from MOBOTIX. The MOBOTIX CLOUD video surveillance-as-a-service (VSaaS) offering allows users to conveniently control their cameras via an app. The recorded videos are stored in highly available and cybersecure data centers located close to the user. Like the MOBOTIX cameras, this solution is "Made in Germany" and meets all GDPR requirements.

The combination of intelligent camera and central cloud platform minimizes bandwidth requirements, as the cameras analyse events on site and only transfer relevant data to the cloud. In accordance

with GDPR requirements, the video recordings are stored in a secure data center that offers both physical protection through security guards and access controls as well as digital protection through encryption.

Communication between the cameras and the MOBOTIX CLOUD takes place via the MOBOTIX Bridge, a highly secure connection unit to the cloud. Outsourcing data storage to the cloud avoids the need for GDPR-compliant on-site protection that would be required with a local NAS solution. The cloud data is managed directly by the user themselves. Around half of the Dunkin' branches have already been migrated to the cloud. And over the next few years, the remaining Dunkin' branches of DFNBG Gastro GmbH & Co. KG are to be migrated to the cloud.
